Executive Summary

Background: The Odem-Edroy ISD (OEISD) is located in San Patricio County in South Texas approximately seven miles northwest of Corpus Christi on U.S. Highway 77, and has a combined population of 4,869. OEISD is a petroleum producing and agricultural area. Agricultural products include cotton, grain sorghum, corn, beef, and cattle. Included in the District is the City of Odem, a retail center located on U.S. Highway 77. The residents of Odem/Edroy enjoy a small-town atmosphere and friendliness while being within seven miles of Corpus Christi where all water activities are available and many cultural events are celebrated throughout the year. Corpus Christi is the home of the Texas State Aquarium and The Lady Lex.

Proposal Evaluation:

Vendors should note detailed costs, clear descriptions and any options available. Odem-Edroy ISD services approximately 1000 students in the region and is streamlined to look for efficiency in costs and services.

Proposals must be a clean comprehensive solution. The costs should include any necessary hardware or software licenses and services. Miscellaneous costs must be included that pertain to training, install, test and any other implementation costs. Site evaluations can be scheduled.

If a need arises for any modifications needed the vendor and Odem-Edroy ISD will mutually negotiate the addition or subtraction of needed resources.

Services Needed:

Landline Phones:

Desktop phone service for 54 phones with voicemail and 8 lines coming into the district.

Cell Phones: 21 current lines with up to the need of 25 lines of service. Options available that require the need for data and text.

Internet Access: Service for up to 1500 users for internet service. Minimum of 20MB up and down and 10GB between campuses (three school buildings and administrative buildings)

Website service: Hosted service for a student population of 1000 students and availability for teacher webpages.
