STAAR

Odem Junior High eighth graders took part in the first round of the 2017 State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness, STAAR, testing on March 28 and 29. Students took the eighth grade mathematics and reading tests. The assessments are part of the criteria needed to be promoted to high school. Eighth grade is considered a Student Success Initiative. SSI was created by the Texas Legislature to ensure all students receive the instruction and support in math and reading needed to be academically successful. Students are required to pass STAAR grade 8 mathematics and reading tests in order to be promoted to ninth grade. The eighth graders have already endured SSI in fifth grade.

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Students in eighth grade have three opportunities to pass the STAAR reading and math tests. If a student does not pass one or both tests, the school will give the student additional instruction after each testing opportunity and the student must participate in that instruction. Parents will be notified if their student doesn't pass a STAAR test required for promotion. If a student does not pass the second testing opportunity a grade placement committee, GPC, is formed. The GPC consists of the principal, teacher, and the parent

or guardian. They will create an instructional plan based on the individual needs of the student.

A student who does not pass STAAR reading or math test after the third testing opportunity will automatically be retained. However, the student's parent or guardian can appeal the decision to have their child repeat the grade by submitting a request to the GPC within five working days of receiving the retention notice. The GPC can decide to promote the student if they agree that he or she will be likely to succeed in the next grade level.

Dear Parents and Guardians:

Starting Tuesday, April 11th all 6th and 7th grade students will be participating in an intensive tutoring program to enhance their **Reading and Math** skills for the upcoming STAAR exams. The Reading exam will be on May 9th and the Math exam will be on May 8th.

Tutoring, for the Math will take place at the Odem Junior High Campus every Tuesday for 6th graders and every Wednesday for 7th graders from 4:00-5:00 p.m. from April 11th through May 3rd. Dr. Veronica Gutierrez, Curriculum Director for Odem-Edroy ISD, is directing the Math tutoring program with Mr. Tierney, Coach Ramirez, Mrs. Sykora, Ms. Gamez and Mrs. Gomez. Tutorial sessions will take place in the designated classrooms. Students are assigned to a classroom and should check with the counseling department or their math teacher for additional information.

Tutoring, for the Reading will take place at the Odem Junior High Campus every Tuesday for 7th graders and every Wednesday for 6th graders from 4:00-5:00 p.m. from April 11th through May 3rd. Dr. Lidamar Yruegas, ELA/Reading Content Specialist for Odem-Edroy ISD, is directing the Reading tutoring program with Ms. Ballard, Mrs. Rodriguez, Ms. Gomez, Mrs. Smith, and Mrs. Salazar. Tutorial sessions will take place in the designated classrooms. Students are assigned to a classroom and should check with the counseling department or their reading teacher for additional information.

Due to the importance of this effort for all students to attend every Tuesday and Wednesday, there will be no practices during tutoring hours. Students will be provided an afternoon snack and busses will be available to transport students after tutoring if needed.

There will be many incentives offered to the students who attend tutorials, including tablets, gift baskets, and a trip. In addition, students will receive an extra 5 minutes for lunch.

A great deal of planning has gone into this program. We want our students to have every possible opportunity to do their very best in May and ask that all parents and guardians support them by making sure they attend every Tuesday and Wednesday from 4:00-5:00 p.m.

Ms. Ballard and Ms. Gamez also have tutorials available on Monday and Thursday for Science and Social Studies.
