#### **Morning Drop-Off:**

- In the drop-off lane, always pull completely forward to allow several students to be dropped off at once. This will allow cars to flow through without causing a large backup or stop in traffic.
- If you wish to get out of your car to walk your child to the building, please park your car in the designated visitor parking area *only*.
- For additional safety measures, please make sure students are exiting the vehicle from the passenger side only (right side of the vehicle).

### Afternoon Pick-Up:

- There will be two pick-up lanes each afternoon in order to prevent a large backup of cars. Please pull completely forward in the pickup lanes until your child is walked out to your car.
- If you wish to get out of your car to wait for your child outside the building, please park your car in the designated visitor parking area only.



Always use the crosswalk when walking to and from the building.



## When is the last day of school for students?

Students that meet the following criteria will be required to attend the final seven days of school from May 22-31, 2019. The day of class for student will be on Tuesday May 21st if the student meets the following requirements:

- •90% Attendance rate for the school year (no more than 17 absences)
- •Have a 70 or higher yearly average in reading/language arts for the school year
- •Have a 70 or higher yearly average in math for the school year
- •Kindergarten TPRI— Developed on Screener and Letter Names & Sounds
