| Shirts Blouses | Shirts/blouses may be: <br> - Any collared shirt/blouse <br> - T-shirts and other pull-over tops <br> - Sweat shirts/sweaters <br> - School designs/logos; brand names or other appropriate words are acceptable. <br> Shirts and blouses must be appropriately worn, buttoned and sized in accordance with design and appropriateness. | Students are prohibited from wearing shirts/blouses and accessories that: <br> - Are oversized or immodestly undersized <br> - Depict or reference alcoholic beverages, drugs, nudity, death, weapons, violence, or obscene or profane slogans or writing that may be expected to cause a disruption or interference with normal school operations <br> - Sleeveless shirts with thin straps (Straps should be at least $11 / 2$ inches in width.) <br> - Off the shoulder tops, undershirts, tank tops, halter tops, racer backs, tube tops, seethrough clothing, pajamas, blouses or clothing with spaghetti straps, or shirts/blouses that expose cleavage or midriff |
| Pants Slacks | - Acceptable pants/slacks are worn appropriately at the waist. <br> - Acceptable pants/slacks fit loosely enough to facilitate movement and modest appearance, yet not sag or bag. <br> - Leggings may be worn under skirts or tops that are longer than the buttocks. | Pants/slacks may not be: <br> - Touching the ground or covering the foot <br> - Baggy or oversized <br> - Fringed or with holes that expose skin above the knee <br> - Worn below the waist (hip huggers) inappropriately revealing |
| Dresses <br> Shorts <br> Skorts <br> Skirts | Dresses/shorts/skorts/skirts are: <br> - Worn at the waist (excluding dresses) <br> - No shorter than 4 inches above the knee <br> - Fit loosely enough to facilitate free movement \& modest appearance Dress tops must meet the guidelines for blouses and shirts. | Dresses, shorts, skorts and skirts may not be: <br> - Slashed apparel that is showing skin <br> - Baggy or oversized <br> - Immodestly split at the hem or seams <br> Proper covering undergarments are to be worn under clothing that is transparent or sheer. |
| Shoes | Shoes must be worn and appropriately secured at all times and chosen for safety, health reasons and for quietness. | House shoes not allowed. <br> Tennis shoes must be worn on P.E. days. |
| Hair | Hair is to be shampooed regularly and kept well groomed. <br> Bangs should not cover the eyebrows. Boys' hair should not exceed the middle of the shirt collar. The length of hair should not pass the bottom of the ear lobe. | Hair is to be styled in a manner so that it stays pulled back from the eyes. Hairstyles of an extreme nature will not be allowed. Mohawks are not allowed. <br> Hair color not within the range of normal hair color, such as purple, green, blue, pink, etc...Shall not be worn. <br> Shaved lines, designs, or verbal messages may not be cut into or otherwise reflected hair style. |


| Jewelry | - Earrings and hair jewelry that are not a safety hazard may be worn by females. <br> - Watches, bracelets, rings and necklaces that are not a safety hazard may be worn by all students. | - Earrings/ear adornments may not be worn by males. <br> - Jewelry (including earrings, chains, emblems, etc.) which is considered to be oversized, a safety hazard, a gang symbol or a distraction is not permitted. |

| General | - For unique special events the campus administrators my establish event specific dress code requirements. <br> - Students shall be dressed and groomed in a manner that is clean and neat and that will enhance high standards of achievement and behavior. <br> - Coats/jackets/sweatshirts shall be appropriately sized. Hoods may not be worn indoors. <br> - Revealing or tight-fitting materials/apparel is not appropriate. | - Hats, caps, or sunglasses shall not be worn indoors except for administrator approved events. <br> - No article of apparel shall be worn that will in any way damage school property, create a safety hazard, or create a distraction. <br> - Clothing and accessories may not reference tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs, nudity, death, weapons, violence, gang affiliation, obscene or profane slogans, inappropriate double meaning, or other emblems or writing. <br> - Students must abide by the dress code and when representing the district in any extracurricular activities, i.e. field trips. |
