Medication Administration Request

When your student's physician determines it is necessary to administer medication during the day, the following procedures must be followed:

- 1. A parent/guardian or responsible adult designee must bring the medication to school.
- 2. All medication must be in the PRESCRIPTION/ORIGINAL CONTAINER clearly labeled with the student's name, the name and dose of medication, and the directions for administration. Parents must provide all medications.
- 3. The Medication Administration Request must be completed by the physician each school year and when there is a medication and/or dose change.
- 4. Only FDA approved pharmaceuticals manufactured in the United States will be administered. HOMEOPATHIC PREPERATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 5. MEDICATIONS WILL NOT BE SENT HOME WITH STUDENTS. All medication must be picked up by a parent/guardian or adult designee.

Medications will be administered under the direct supervision of the school nurse. Designated employees can administer to students also.
