

# Teacher Web Page Rubric

## Rules:

1. Only teachers will be eligible for the prizes.
2. Evaluation will occur on MAY periodically during school year.
3. Each teacher's webpage will be given the average score of the 3 judges.
4. The highest scoring teacher will receive a prize.
5. The final committee will consist of the superintendent, the curriculum director and a guest evaluator.
6. Final evaluators may add additional requirements to aid in their determination.
7. The winners will be announced on the last teacher workday.
8. The final selection committee will determine the prizes to be give to the winners.

## Web Page Evaluation:

- The Class Schedule section MUST include subjects and grades taught, the conference time and goal/objectives for the year.
- Lesson Information should reflect the requirements for the current lesson and must have a date indicator
- Additional information and features must be up to date.
- Overall Creativity points may be added after the final score is calculated.
