## **Teacher Web Page Rubric**

## Rules:

- 1. Only teachers will be eligible for the prizes.
- 2. Evaluation will occur on MAY periodically during school year.
- 3. Each teacher's webpage will be given the average score of the 3 judges.
- 4. The highest scoring teacher will receive a prize.
- 5. The final committee will consist of the superintendent, the curriculum director and a guest evaluator.
- 6. Final evaluators may add additional requirements to aid in their determination.
- 7. The winners will be announced on the last teacher workday.
- 8. The final selection committee will determine the prizes to be give to the winners.

Web Page Evaluation:

- The Class Schedule section MUST include subjects and grades taught, the conference time and goal/objectives for the year.
- Lesson Information should reflect the requirements for the current lesson and must have a date indicator
- Additional information and features must be up to date.
- Overall Creativity points may be added after the final score is calculated.
