School Bus Rider Rules

- Students must be respectful to the driver and fellow students and must always follow directions of the driver.
- Talking is permitted, however no yelling or screaming is allowed.
- Standing is not allowed, students must sit in their seats, face front, feet on the floor at all times.
- Eating or drinking is not permitted, water is allowed.
- Students are not allowed to sit in the driver's seat, operate the door, emergency exits and/or any other driver controls except in case of an evacuation or directed to do so by the driver.
- Damaging, marking on, tagging, or vandalizing any part of the bus is forbidden. Violators will be required to pay damages.
- Fighting is prohibited.
- Bullying will not be tolerated.
- The use of obscene, vulgar, or profane language and/or gestures is forbidden. This also includes gang signs.
- Do not extend head, hands, arms or legs out of the window, nor hold anything out of the window.
- Throwing things inside the bus as well as out the windows is prohibited
